Based on:

- Provisions of Articles 14 and 25 of Law on Energy Regulator,
- Provisions of Article 4.2 and 22.2 of the Transmission System Operator License;
- Provisions of Article 7.4 of the Market Operator License;
- Application of KOSTT for derogation of provisions under Grid Code, Metering Code, Market Rules and Transmission System Operator License,

in its session held on 15 June 2015, issued the following:

DECISION

- I** **KOSTT is hereby granted** the derogation in implementation of the provisions under Grid Code, Metering Code, Market Rules and Transmission System Operator License, as in the annex of this Decision.

Reasoning

On 2 June 2015, Energy Regulatory Office (ERO) received the application of KOSTT for derogation in implementation of the provisions under Grid Code, Metering Code, Market Rules and Transmission System Operator License, Following the assessment of the application, and taking into account the current situation of the Transmission System, the ERO Board considered as reasonable to allow the derogation in implementation of the provisions under Grid Code, Metering Code, Market Rules and Transmission System Operator License, as in the time limits set forth in the Annex.

All other provisions of the Grid Code, Metering Code, Market Rules and Transmission System Operator License, shall remain in force.

- II** The Decision shall be issued in Albanian language and will be translated into Serbian and English. In case of any discrepancy between the versions, the Albanian version shall prevail.



III This Decision shall enter into force on the date of approval by the Board and will be published in the ERO's official website.

Legal advice: The party dissatisfied with this Decision may address to the Competent Court, within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of this Decision or the date of its publication in the ERO website, whichever occurs last.
