- Provisions of Articles 14 and 25 of the Law on Energy Regulator,
- Provisions of Article 22 of the Rule on Licensing of Energy Activities in Kosovo,
- Provision of Article 4 of the Distribution System Operator License,
- Request of the OCGC on amending the Distribution Metering Code, dated 17 December 2013,

in its session held on 12 March 2014, issued the following:

D E C I S I O N

I Approving the amendments of the Distribution Metering Code

Reasoning

The Energy Regulatory Office on December 17, 2013 received an OCGC's request to amend the Distribution Metering Code, harmonized with changes in primary legislation and other changes that have occurred. In this context some language improvements and text adjustments have been made also. ERO, as an active participant in the OCGC, has provided its comments during the amending period.

On February 29, 2012 between KEK and KOSTT was signed the Agreement on transfer of assets based on the decision No. 10/29 the Government of the Republic of Kosovo. After this agreement, ERO, on June 15, 2012 issued the decision No. V_403_2012 approving the transfer of 400/220/110 kV assets including also the 220/35/10 (20) kV transformers, as well as lands, buildings, auxiliary equipment and employees form KEK JSC to KOSTT JSC. It is necessary for the changes arising from this agreement to be incorporated in the Distribution Metering Code.

Following these developments, the OCGC amended the document in accordance with the legal changes and transfer of assets, and on December 17, 2013 made a formal request for approval of amendments made to the Distribution Metering Code.

ERO, following the evaluation of the request, considered it as reasonable to allow the amending of the Distribution Metering Code. All other provisions of the Distribution Metering Code shall remain in force.



- II The Decision shall be issued in Albanian language and will be translated into Serbian and English. In the event of any discrepancy between the versions, the Albanian version shall prevail.
- III This Decision shall enter into force on the date of approval by the Board of the Energy Regulator, and shall be published in the official website of ERO.

Legal Advice: The party dissatisfied with this Decision may address to the Competent Court, within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of the Decision or the date of its publication in the ERO website, whichever occurs last.
