- Provisions of Articles 14 and 25 of the Law on Energy Regulator
- Provisions of Article 49.2 of the Rule on Licensing of Energy Activities in Kosovo
- Provisions of Article 4 of the Transmission System Operator License
- Request of KOSTT J.S.C dated in June 2014 on Derogation of provisions of the Grid Code, Metering Code, Market Rule and Transmission System Operator License

in the session held on 30 June 2014, issued the following:

DECISION

- I Allowing KOSTT J.S.C. Derogation from implementation of provisions of the Grid Code, Metering Code, Market Rule and Transmission System Operator License as in Appendix of this Decision**

Justification

The Energy Regulatory Office (ERO) on 28 May 2014 received from KOSTT SH.A. the request for derogation from implementation of certain provisions of the Grid Code, Metering Code, Market Rule and Transmission System Operator License. Following review of the request and given the current situation of the Transmission Grid, ERO deemed reasonable to allow a postponement in implementing the provisions of the Grid Code, Metering Code, Market Rule and Transmission System Operator License as in the timelines set out in the Appendix.

All other provisions of the Grid Code, Metering Code, Market Rule and Transmission System Operator License shall remain in force.

- II** The Decision shall be issued in Albanian language and will be translated into Serbian and English. In the event of any discrepancy between the versions, the version in Albanian shall prevail.
- III** This Decision shall enter into force on the date of approval by the ERO Board and shall be published in the official website of ERO.

Derogation – Grid Code, Metering Code, Market Rule and TSO License



Legal Remedy: The party dissatisfied with this Decision may address to the Competent Court, within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of the Decision or the date of its publication in the ERO website, whichever occurs last.
