## PRESS RELEASE

The Energy Regulatory Office (ERO), in the meeting held today 24 March 2010, decided that electricity tariffs for regulated customers to take effect from 1 April 2010 are to remain the same with the last year's tariffs.

At this meeting, the Board reviewed the applications from Kosova Energy Corporation (KEK) JSC and the Kosova Transmission, System and Market Operator (KOSTT) JSC, comments submitted from other stakeholders and the final decision on new tariffs.

The Board approved the ERO's final proposal on the level of Allowed Revenues for KEK and KOSTT, i.e. tariffs, as the comments received did not provide any argument that would amend ERO's preliminary proposal. The level of Revenues to be recovered from the new tariffs is 156.4 million Euros for KEK, which includes 18.1 million Euros for KOSTT.

This is the fourth electricity tariff review which is a process that implies evaluation of KEK and KOSTT Allowed Revenues to be recovered from electricity tariffs for regulated customers.
