Sixth Session of ERO Board

Today, on 3 November 2021, the Board of Energy Regulatory Office (ERO) held its sixth session for this year.

In this session, the Board decided on Maximum Allowed Revenues of District Heating (DH) "Termokos". Following the public discussion, the Board reviewed the comments of the parties regarding the published Consultation Report, and decided to approve the Maximum Allowed Revenues for DH "Termokos" for the heating season 2021/22. The amount of Maximum Allowed Revenues for this season is 7,185,202 €.

Based on the approved revenues, the Board also decided on determination of tariffs of DH "Termokos" for this season. The thermal energy tariff structure contains two types of tariffs: tariffs for "metered" customers and tariffs for "unmetered" customers, depending on the infrastructure of thermal energy meters.

For metered customers, the monthly tariff for thermal capacity is 0.78 €/kW per month and 36.25 €/MWh for the supplied amount of thermal energy. For unmetered customers, the tariffs are based on the heating area which will be calculated at 0.76 €/m² per month for household customers and 0.95 €/m² for commercial customers.
